New safety barrier installed at Lewis Creek County Park

Linn County Parks staff members have been busy installing a new safety barrier at Lewis Creek County Park on Foster Reservoir.

The \$255,000 barrier is designed to stop a 27-foot boat going 60 miles per hour in less than a second.
