ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Linn County Mental Health has an available position for an experienced therapist to work with a wide range of consumers experiencing a mental health crisis. Duties include conducting admission screenings and intakes in the Hospital Emergency rooms. Must be willing to work as part of an interdisciplinary team and follow documentation requirements in accordance with the Oregon Administrative Rules and department policies and procedures. Having upgraded skills in medical management information system that support clinical work is desired. An ability to pass a criminal history check and have a valid Oregon drivers' license is required. This position is part time on-call position during the evening, weekend hours, and must be able to respond to hospital within one hour of being called on a County provided device.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Mental Health Specialist 1:

Master's Degree in psychology, social work, counseling, or related field is required. Professional or supervised practicum-level experience in providing similar services to persons with similar problems or concerns is desirable but not required. Any satisfactory equivalent combination of experience, education and training which demonstrates the ability to perform the work described may be acceptable.

Mental Health Specialist 2:

Master's Degree in psychology, social work, counseling or related field is required. Two years post Master's Degree supervised experience in a similar position. Classification as a Mental Health Specialist 2, in addition to the requirements listed in the Experience, Education and Training Section above requires Oregon licensure as a Licensed Professional Counselor or Licensed Clinical Social Worker.

SALARY, BENEFITS, COMPENSATION:

Linn County offers a standby rate plus a per visit rate. The rate depends on the number of patients seen during your scheduled worked hours. The rate is based on current Collective Bargaining Agreements.
