- Perform Diagnostic Functions Utilizing Computerized and Traditional Diagnostic Tools
- Repair Transmissions, Differentials and Other Gear Boxes
- Test and Repair Construction Equipment Hydraulic and Pneumatic Systems
- Perform General Welding using Oxyacetylene and Electric Arc Welding Equipment, Fabricate Special Parts and Equipment
- Repair and Rebuild Truck Beds, Boxes, Graders and Loader Buckets
- Other Duties as Assigned
